

2016-2017 Early Years Foundation Stage Results: Headline figures – Durley Church of England Primary School

The information on this page compares the percentage of children at Durley who have attained a 'Good Level of Development' by the end of Year R to children nationally and other children in Hampshire. Children are defined as having reached a good level of development at the end of the EYFS if they have achieved at least the expected level in:

- the early learning goals in the prime areas of learning (personal, social and emotional development; physical development; and communication and language)
- and;
- the early learning goals in the specific areas of mathematics and literacy.

The table below shows the data from 2016 - 2017.

58.8% of Durley pupils attained a good level of development across all key areas.

75.7% of pupils in Hampshire attained a good level of development across all key areas.

70.7% of pupils nationally attained a good level of development across all key areas.
