

2017 KS1 SATs Results: Headline figures – Durley Church of England Primary School



This is the second year of the new testing and assessment arrangements for Year 2. These arrangements reflect the more challenging national curriculum which was introduced in 2014.

At the end of KS1 (Yr2), teachers are required to assess each child in the areas of reading, writing, maths and science. National Curriculum assessment tests are used to support teachers' judgements.

The system of national curriculum levels has been removed and the new measures are as follows:

Expected Standard – Working at the expected standard for a child at the end of Year 2

Greater Depth – Working at greater depth within the expected standard, with a strong understanding of the curriculum

75% of Durley pupils reached the new expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics with **25%** reaching Greater Depth.

70% of pupils in Hampshire reached the new expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics with **15%** reaching Greater Depth.

64% of pupils nationally reached the new expected standard in reading, writing and mathematics with **11%** reaching Greater Depth.
