#### **Attendance**

I recognise the difficulties that families have had over the past two years with booking holidays and cancellations due to Covid however it is vital that children do not miss the school days that are available to them. Staff are working extremely hard to ensure there are not any gaps from time missed from face to face teaching. Please can you ensure that your child is in school unless there are exceptional circumstances. The school strictly follows Government guidance which states that a family holiday is not considered an exceptional circumstance. 5 days (10 sessions) of unauthorised absence

will lead to a fixed penalty notice fine. Any unpaid fines or two penalty notices within 100 days could lead to legal action which can cost thousands of pounds and a criminal record.

#### Reminders

Please remember to send in your child's full PE kit each week. In the current cold weather children may wear dark coloured (blue or black) tracksuit bottoms for outdoor PE lessons.

Please could children have a water bottle in school each day containing plain water only.

Finally, trainers for everyday wear are not part of our Durley School uniform. I would be most grateful if you could ensure your child is wearing proper school shoes.
