Dear Parents

Please can I remind you that particular care needs to be taken with children walking along the pavement at the start and end of the school day, particularly where cars are parked on the pavement and when walking past the driveway to the houses. This week there was a very near miss with a child running across the entrance to a driveway as a car was driving in. Fortunately the driver spotted the child at the last minute and was able to stop. We are currently talking to children in Blue and Yellow classes about road safety and the importance of not running on ahead of parents. We would be very grateful if you could follow this up at home. We are delighted that the Parish Council have secured a grant of £10 000 to fund a drop curb crossing across to Quob stables and new flashing school lights with recommended 20 mile an hour signs on the approach to the school. These should be installed before April 2020.

We have also been speaking to the children in Blue and yellow classes about respecting the early morning activities that are set up on the KS1 playground before school in preparation for the mornings learning. We would be very grateful for your support in ensuring that the activities are not touched or played with by your children.
