Dear Parents

In the event of a school closure.....

The children were very excited to see a few flurries of snow yesterday and anticipating that there might be more to come. We are keeping a close eye on the weather forecast which at the moment is indicating that there may be snow towards the end of this week. I thought it might be helpful to remind you of the procedures should we need to close the school. In the first instance the office staff will contact you by email and text as well as putting a notice on the front page of our school website. We will also contact Hantsnet to inform them that we are closed to enable them to put it on their school closure website. We will do this as early in the morning as possible to prevent you from making an unnecessary journey.

If we start to have heavy snow during the school day we will contact you following the same procedure. If you are unable to collect your child could you please make an arrangement for a friend, relative or neighbour to collect and inform the school office preferably by email—adminoffice@durley.hants.sch.uk

Despite my love of sledging, I am always reluctant to close the school and will take into account the staffing that we have available on site and safety of your children before making the decision to close. Please could you ensure that your contact details are up to date and let the office know immediately if anything has changed.

We are still finding that some children are coming into school without coats or school jumpers. Please could you ensure that in this cold weather that children have warm clothes to wear outside during the playtimes. We are also more than happy for children to bring in leggings or track-suit bottoms to wear for outdoor PE lessons.
