Dear Parents and Carers,

This week, the children in Years 5 and 6 are on their residential visit to the Isle of Wight. They will be away all week. We wish them the very best of luck and look forward to their return and hearing about their many adventures.

I felt very proud watching a group of our Year 4 and 5 pupils singing on the stage at the Thornden Hall last week, as part of our Wyvern Cluster vocal festival, it was a wonderful performance.

Thank you to everyone who took part in the Dare 2 Dream LENT project sale – either buying or selling. The children raised an amazing £420 for the charity. I have been hearing of many other

ingenious ways of fundraising from our children. One of our pupils in Red class designed a 'spot the ball' competition for his friends and family raising £31 and a group of Year 4 pupils have undertaken a sponsored litter pick around the village. They have collected 4 large bags of rubbish and already raised an incredible £170. Parking on the Track!

We completely understand that parking outside the school is not easy however I would like to politely remind you that unfortunately we are **NOT** able to provide parking for parents and relatives on the school track for the following reasons. Firstly, we try to limit the number of cars using the

track at the start and end of the school day for the safety of children crossing. Secondly, even if it appears that there is a space for parking, we have staff and visitors needing to attend the children's clubs at the end of the day. If a member of staff cannot find a parking space, we have children waiting around for the clubs to start. Finally, we have a limited number of spaces which are only available for agreed accessible parking and not for general use. The track is a privately owned footpath and access road for users of the properties beyond the school. Please can I ask that this reminder is communicated to anybody dropping off or collecting who will not have access to this newsletter.
